- More flexibility is needed (dealing with equipment)

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II. TAST performance

- TAST experts should be more familiarized with the OSOCC work
- Knowing priorities (their own vs. TACO), lack of clear leading structure
- Need to perform also other TAST support functions
- Identify TAST members skills/functions before deployment
